One animal for \$40 can enter halter, the three performance classes and showmanship. Big savings for you! But the savings doesn't stop there - Get of Sire and Produce of Dam entry fees have been reduced.

**FUN AWARDS:** Dress up in your Hobo apparel. You may win a prize for the best Hobo costume Saturday and Sunday. Dirtiest animal awarded on Sunday. Other fun prizes too — Early Bird, Farthest Traveled, Most Entries and more.

**NO GROOM:** Remember the days when you got arrested for grooming your animal? Fined a dollar when your animal pooped in the show ring? Issued a ticket for leaving your animal unattended? Caught in possession of a brush? Finding someone to post your bond? Be ready and bring those dollar bills! Proceeds go to LANA Lama Lifeline.

**HEALTH REQUIREMENTS:** Health certificates are not required for llamas and alpacas from California or entering California from another state at this time. Any animals showing evidence of infectious, contagious or communicable diseases must be immediately withdrawn from the show and removed from the grounds, along with all animals with which they were trailered or stalled.

**REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS:** Llamas and Alpacas must be registered with the ILR or AOA. See the ALSA Handbook for exact rules. Copies of the Registration Certificates must be sent with the entry form.

**ADVERTISING/SPONSORSHIP:** Advertising is available through sponsorship. Please submit a camera ready advertisement or business card by email to Joy at **lanaquestions@gmail.com**. Files must be in .jpeg or .png. Your ad will also be included in the special Hobo edition of the LANA newsletter and on the LANA website. **LANA MEMBERSHIP**: Membership fees vary by type of membership. Please check LANA's website for more information. Check the Sponsorship information about membership discounts for sponsors.

**VENDORS:** Vendors are welcome. There is a \$25.00 fee for a 12 x 12 space or FREE with your \$100 Hobo Sponsorship or free with your Friends of LANA sponsorship for \$250 (free vendor space at all LANA sponsored events and shows for 2024, except California State Fair). You will need to supply your own set-up (tables, chairs, etc.).

**SILENT AUCTION:** Plenty of auction action at Hobo. There is a special silent auction with higher end items. Proceeds go to Lama Lifeline which helps camelids in crisis. There's another silent auction that benefits LANA's general fund to support LANA's activities through out the year. Both auctions end Saturday evening. If you are bringing an item(s) for the auction, please fill out the auction tag which can be found in this packet, as well as on LANA's website. After dinner on Saturday evening, the very popular and entertaining dessert auction will take place.

**CAMPING:** RV camping is available at the Fairgrounds with electrical, water and sewage hookup for \$35.00 per night. Vehicle and/or trailer camping with electrical hookup is \$25.00 per night. You can pick your spot when you arrive. Camping spaces should be reserved on your entry form. There is no tent camping available, however the Fairgrounds will allow you to sleep in your vehicle/trailer without any hookup at no charge.

**STALLING:** Self-penning is in the Glacier Barn. Cost for self-penning is \$5 per head. Stalling will be first come, first serve. You will need to bring your own panels. The Fairgrounds does not have any panels suitable for Ilamas. No self-penning on the grass. If you are coming only for the day, there is a grounds fee at \$5 per head. YOU **MUST CLEAN** YOUR PENS AND STALLING AREA BEFORE YOU LEAVE.

**PARKING:** Please park in designated areas after you have unloaded. Trailer parking is near the barn.

**DOGS:** Dogs are welcome at the show but must be on leash or penned at all times. Please be mindful of the animals in and around the show ring.
